Camp Silvercloud - members implement a camp in the summer for mentally and physically challenged children.

Children's Shelter - members provide activities, parties and babysitting for children living at the Warren County Children's Shelter.

Community Outreach - members help stock the VWSD Pride Closet, execute a Health and Safety Fair, and assist with various special needs in the community.

Dave Ramsey Project - members teach high school students Dave Ramsey's Foundations in Personal Finance in order to bring awareness to debt, saving, college funding, investing, and retirement planning. In addition, an understanding of bills, the true cost of car and home ownership, and the cost of running a household is brought to their attention.

Family Development - members provide young disadvantaged mothers and children with the knowledge, skills and supplies necessary for quality child rearing.

LEAP - to teach nutrition and fitness to school-aged children to promote healthy choices.

Safety Town - members teach basic safety in the community during a five day camp in the summer.
